SPEAKERS EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

The Australasian Milling Conference will be held on the 29 – 31 May 2016 in conjunction with the Poultry Information Exchange (**PIX / AMC 2016**). The Conference will be held at the Gold Coast Convention & Exhibition Centre on the Gold Coast in sunny Queensland.

The Conference theme is “***Sustainability – Key Concepts for our Future?***”

Both international and local speakers will contribute to the program addressing a range of topics relating to the **feed, flour and poultry industries**. The emphasis of the conference is to challenge existing industry practices and gain a better insight into sustainable practices. PIX/AMC 2014 was attended by more than 1400 people with over 200 exhibition booths. The 2016 Conference is expected to gain a similar or better attendance.

Delegates attend the conference representing all the major flour, feed and poultry producing companies operating within Australia.

Speaker Expression of Interest

The Australasian Milling Conference Programme Committee is extending an opportunity for additional speakers to present at the conference.

Expressions of Interest to present a paper at the 2016 Australasian Milling Conference are now called for.

We are seeking papers from companies or individuals that relate to the Conference theme. The programme allows for split flour and feed sessions as well as combined sessions, so Expressions of Interest can be submitted to address either industry sector, or both. Some general areas of interest will include:

- Innovations in milling equipment and practices.
- Developments impacting upon either flour or feed manufacturing
- Sustainability for the three major cost areas:
 - Raw Materials – i.e. Grain storage and handling
 - Energy
 - and Labour

Suppliers to the flour and feed industries are given the opportunity to provide presentations on new product developments or innovations relating to products or services they supply to flour and feed manufacturers. Emphasis is placed upon NEW developments rather than promotion of existing technologies.

Expressions of Interest should provide the following:

1. Proposed name of the presenter
2. Organisation presenter is representing
3. Proposed title of the presentation
4. Brief summary or abstract defining areas the presentation would cover

Presentations will be limited to 20-30 minutes and written papers will be required prior to the Conference for inclusion within the proceedings supplied to attending delegates.

The Conference Organising Committee reserves the right to select from Expressions of Interest submitted those which best meet the needs of the Conference. The decision to accept or reject proposed presentations will be final and successful Expressions of Interest will be advised accordingly.
